KIS Celebrates Anniversary by Giving

KIS International School, a full IB World school, celebrated its 10th Anniversary by raising funds to build a library for Rama 9 District Center. In line with the strong community ethos of KIS and the "supported by community" theme of this anniversary, KIS celebrated the occasion by supporting the education of underprivileged children.

The Rama 9 District Center supports children whose families work during the day. With no home library, the children will have better access to books and teachers will have improved resources to teach the children, who range in age from five to six years old.

Fundraising efforts were kicked off by the KIS Fun Fair and continued with fundraising initiatives including a bake sale, book sale, craft sale, art auction, guitar afternoon, fair, fun, theater production and more. The KIS Community exceeded the target of raising

500,000 Baht and managed to gather over 811,000 Baht to donate to the Day care center.

In May, the children and staff of the Rama 9 District center were invited to come to KIS for the donation hand-over day. This day started with children from the center enjoying fun games and balloon animals. The presentation programme featured a mixture from the Primary Years Programme Drama Club performance "Alice" and the drama using lively performance from the English Language World of IB by the MYP Drama Club. Children from Rama 9 also visited KIS to see our amazing 2400 tonnes in their cultural operation.
